Expanded Cafeteria Space

- ➤ Santo ISD has outgrown the current 1969-era cafeteria that serves PK-12th grade students
- ► Elementary lunch service starts at 10:30 due to limited seating space
- ► Current cafeteria space: 5,500 sq/ft
- Proposed, repurposed gymnasium to cafeteria increases to 12,000 sq/ft
- ▶ New and larger serving line and kitchen space



Inclement Weather Recess Area

- Current cafeteria would be repurposed into a multi-use space for the elementary campus
- Could be used for recess on inclement weather days/excessive heat days
- ► Stage area would remain for smaller events like Thanksgiving Play, Spelling & Math Bees
- Would eliminate conflict with One Act Play practice, as Proposed Bond would provide them a repurposed practice/storage facility



What Taxpayers Should Know About Proposition 4

Proposition 4 is one of 14 Constitutional Amendments on the ballot on November 7th. It reduces school tax rates in Texas and increases the Homestead Exemption from \$40,000 to \$100,000.

Passage of Prop 4 would reduce the Tax Bill on a \$200,000 home in Santo ISD almost 50%*



*with properly filed Homestead Exemption and no change in property value

2022 (current year)

Tax Rate Tax BII \$0.94 \$1,508.64

2023 (next year)

Tax Rate Tax Bll \$0.78 \$784.40
